Fisher Ultra-Spray pre rinse spray valves only use 1.6 gpm at 80 psi compared to 3 gpm or higher on other spray valves used in commercial kitchens. A **\$25.00 vendor rebate** is also available for this valve.

Conservacap saves 3/4 of a gallon per flush (gpf) on older Sloan or Zurn flushometers fixtures using 3.5 gpf or 4.5 gpf without effecting the performance or functionality. It provides a **21% savings** and is a low cost interim step rather than replacing the fixture with a new 1.6 gpf low flow fixture.
